

To All Residents of Bearspaw Village

Please find enclosed our invoice for February.

You will note that we are not yet invoicing for your actual water consumption as during February the Blazer and Bearspaw Village water systems were not yet inter-connected and active. Please also note that we have adjusted the water consumption fee from the earlier indicated \$1.93 per m3 to the amount previously negotiated with the Board of the Bearspaw Village Water Co-Op of \$1.889 per m3.

Additionally, a new line item has been added to the invoice, being the Bearspaw Village Assessment, in the amount of \$50.00. This sum was determined by the Board of the BPV and will be included in our invoice on a monthly basis. The amount will be collected by Blazer and will be remitted to BPV in accordance with the terms of our Agreement with BPV. The Board of BPV will review the amount of the assessment from time to time to ensure that an adequate contingency balance is available in the BPV Contingency Account to pay for any agreed charges due to Blazer and/or to pay for any breakage or damage to the BPV water line distribution system.

The BPV Board wishes to take this opportunity to reconfirm to BPV residents that the Board is paying for the other ongoing community expenses and commitments through utilization of previously collected monies now held in the Bearspaw Village Reserve Fund.
